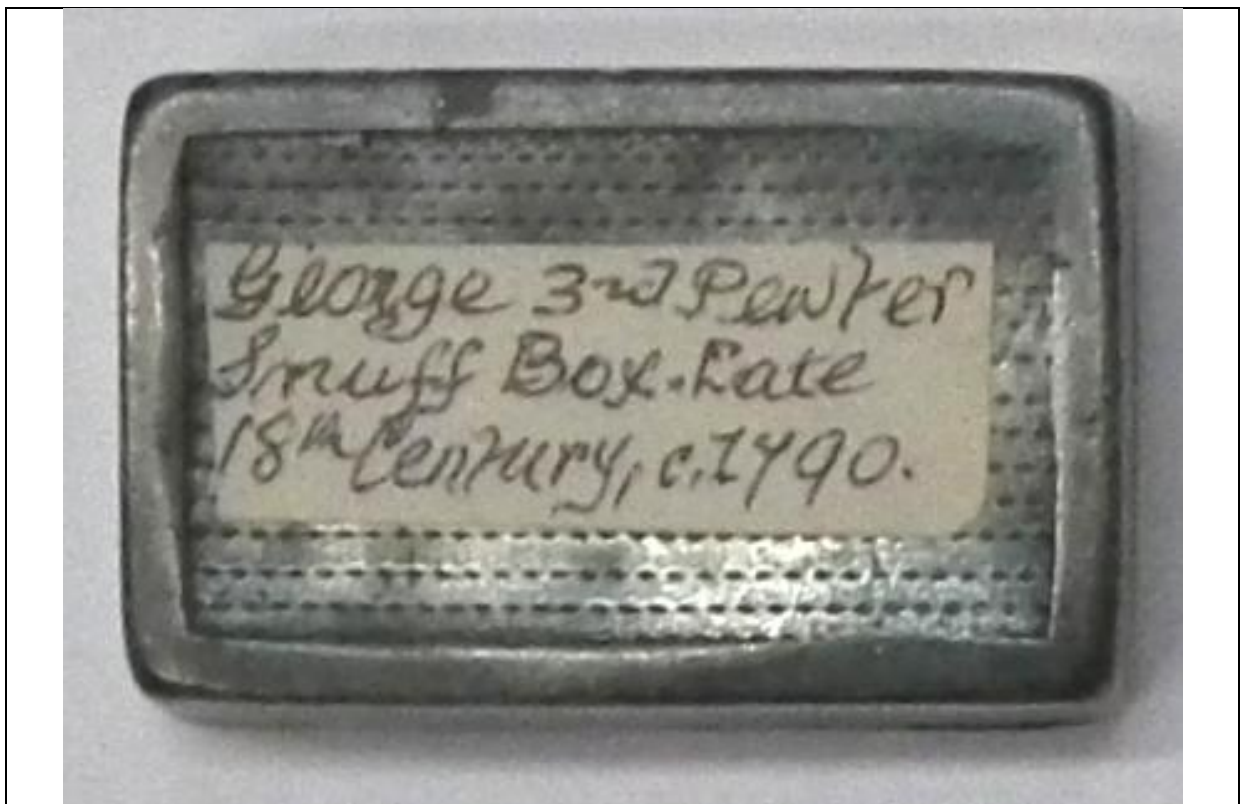

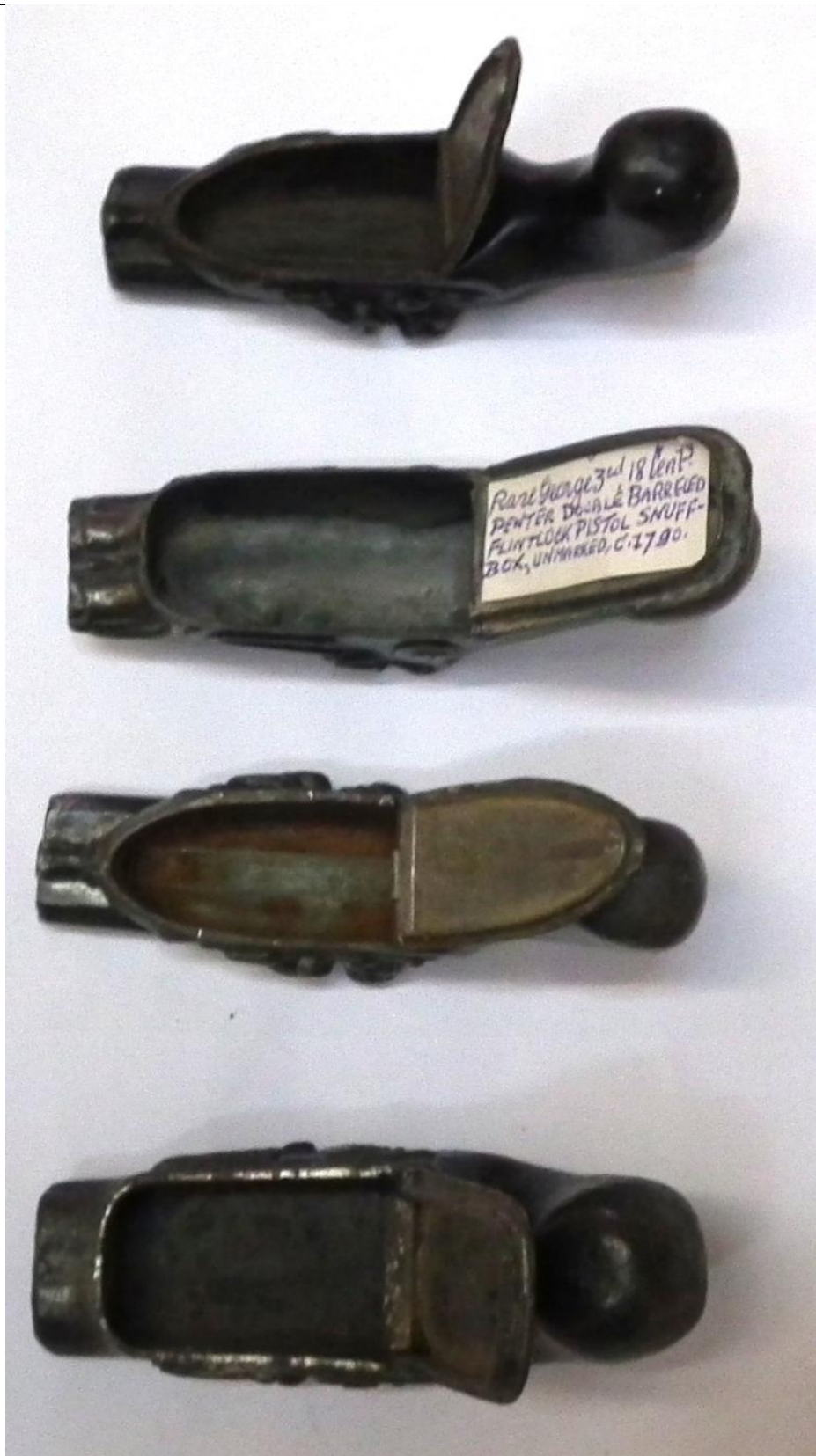

Pistol snuff boxes shown open



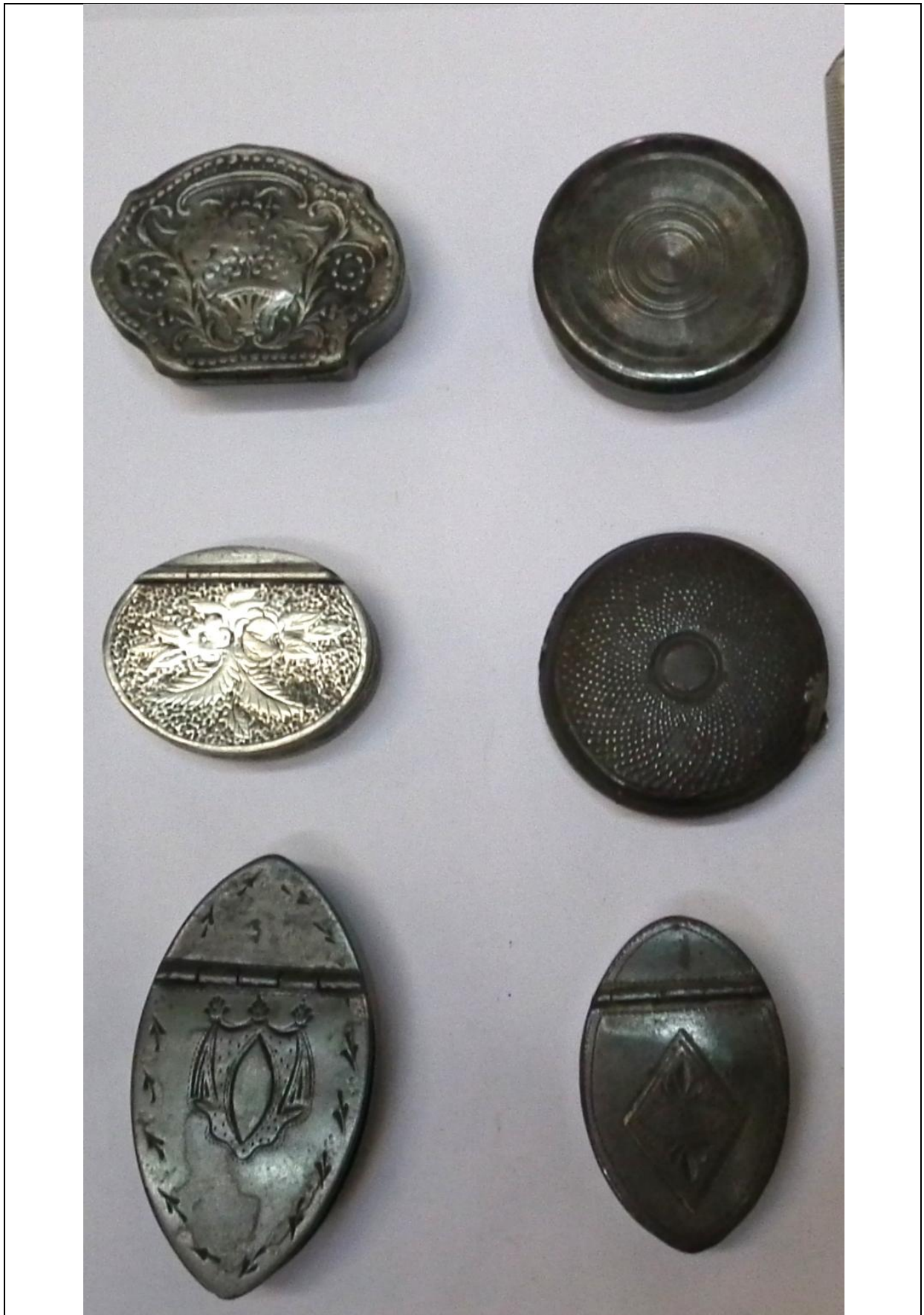


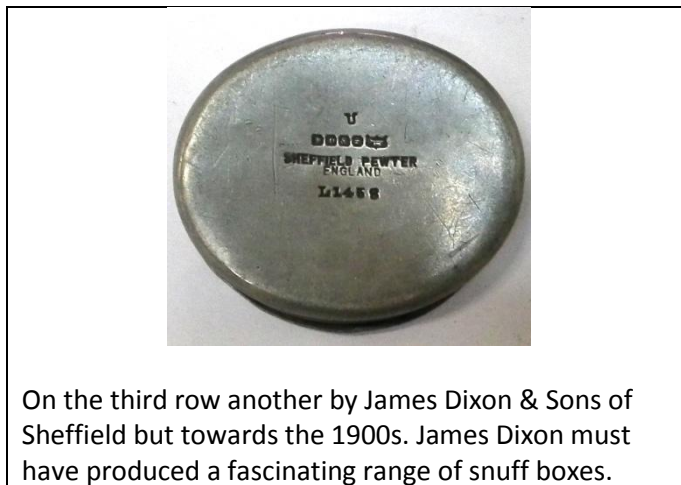
Below - this is not a snuff box but is in the same display and ownership and is an unusual Pewter weight. We might assume 5 ounces.
